His death on the cross purchased for us the gift of His forgiveness. Forgiveness is applied to the person who intentionally receives it by faith. You can exercise your faith by praying to God that you desire to be right with Him through Christ, you trust that He alone can pay for your sins, and you desire to receive His forgiveness. You have assurance that "if you confess with your mouth, *"Jesus is Lord," and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved"* Romans 10:9.

The Bible says *"if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; the old has gone, the new has come"* (2 Corinthians 5:17). His forgiveness gives us a new start. Life and relationships formerly twisted by sin are cleansed and set free to live as God always intended.
