Jesus affirms those who accept His invitation.

Jesus <u>assures</u> the faithful they will experience difficulties.

Jesus commands joy and promises reward.

Confession: **R**ealize I'm not God. I admit I am powerless to control my tendency to do the wrong thing and that my life is unmanageable. (5:3; poor in spirit)

Contrition: Earnestly believe that God exists. I matter to Him, and He has the power to help me recover. (5:4; mourn)

Control: **C**onsciously choose to commit all my life and will to Christ's care and control. (5:5; humble)

Critique: **O**penly examine and confess my faults to myself, to God, and to someone I trust. (5:8; pure in heart)

Craving: Voluntarily submit to every change God wants to make in my life and humbly ask Him to remove my character defects. (5:6; hunger and thirst for righteousness)

Compassion: Evaluate all my relationships, offer forgiveness to those who've hurt me, and make amends for harm I've done to others except when to do so would harm them or others. (5:7, merciful; 5:9, peacemakers)

<u>Consistency</u>: Reserve a daily time with God for self-examination, Bible reading, and prayer in order to know God and His will for my life and to gain power to follow His will. (5:6; hunger and thirst)

<u>Conflict</u>: Yield myself to God to be used to bring this Good News to others, both by my example and my words. (5:10, persecuted)

Suffer. Remember. Rejoice.


